Throughout the Cincinnati region, Northern Kentucky University (NKU), Thomas More University, Xavier University, Miami University, and the University of Cincinnati all add information technology talent to the pipeline. In late 2022, Northern Kentucky-based Global Business Solutions, Inc. partnered with NKU to open the GBS Tech and Innovation Center on NKU's campus. This center serves as a training ground for NKU's cybersecurity and information technology students.

The NKU College of Informatics (COI) is also one of just a handful of such colleges nationally and Gateway Community & Technical College offers training to build IT talent.

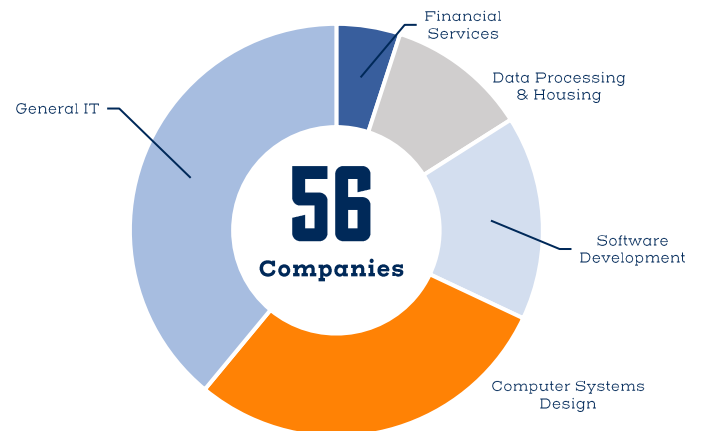

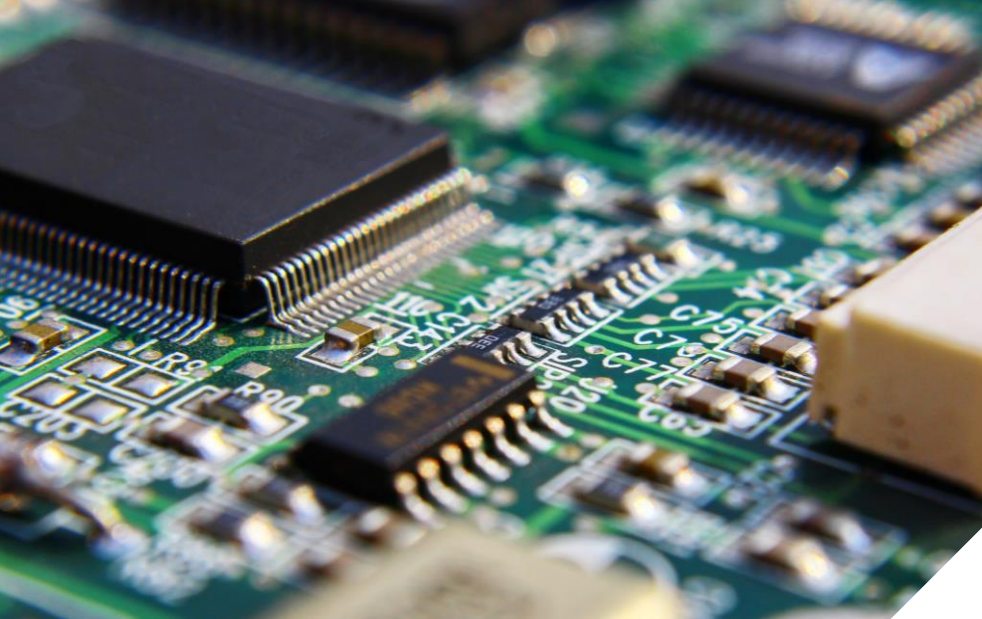
